Choose up to 18 additional credits at Milwaukee Area Tech. College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill general education and business core requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

**Choose up to 18 credits from the following areas:**

- Arts/Humanities General Education Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Natural Science General Education Requirement – up to 6 credits
- Cultures General Education Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Business Core Requirement – up to 15 credits
- Elective Credits – up to 3 credits in any academic area
