Maximize Your Transfer to UIU

Take up to 18 credits to fulfill general education and graduation requirements.

Choose up to 18 additional credits at Milwaukee Area Technical College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill general education and graduation requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

Choose up to 18 credits from the following areas:

- Arts/Humanities General Education Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Communication (Written) General Education Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Computer Skills General Education Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Natural Science General Education Requirement – up to 6 credits
- Prerequisite Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Free Electives – up to 12 credits in any academic area
