To apply for a social work training certificate, the State of Wisconsin requires students to have grades of C or above in all social work equivalency courses (PSY/SOC 383, PSY 391, PSY 392, PSY 393, and SOC 384) and at least a 2.5 GPA in the major. Students must meet specific standards and demonstrate identified competencies through an assessment process before they will be approved for an internship. This degree plan has been approved by the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (DSPS). The social work equivalency courses may also be incorporated into UIU's Psychology or Criminal Justice majors per DSPS rules. Completion of the major does not guarantee social work certification. For clarification of these and other state requirements, please contact the DSPS.

A minimum of 120 semester credits is required for a baccalaureate degree; up to 78 lower-division college semester credits from Milwaukee Area Technical College. A minimum of 30 credits must be upper-division credits for a UIU baccalaureate degree; lower-division transfer work from Milwaukee Area Technical College does not contribute to the upper-division credit requirement at UIU.

## Maximize Your Transfer to UIU

*Take up to 14 credits to fulfill general education and major requirements.*

Choose up to 14 additional credits at Milwaukee Area Technical College to transfer into Upper Iowa University to fulfill general education and major requirements. Talk with your advisors to ensure additional courses will fit with your degree plan and financial aid requirements.

**Choose up to 14 credits from the following areas:**

- Arts/Humanities General Education Requirement – up to 6 credits
- Communication (Written) General Education Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Computer Skills General Education Requirement – up to 3 credits
- Natural Science General Education Requirement – up to 6 credits
- Prerequisite requirement – up to 3 credits
- Major Requirements – up to 6 credits
