Planning to Commute to Campus?

All students are required to live in University residence halls. All requests to live off Campus are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Students who fail to take up residency or move off Campus without permission will be charged a \$3,000 penalty fee per year for the duration of the residency requirement. They will also be required to enroll, at a minimum, in the 80-Meal Commuter Meal Plan every year for the duration of the residency requirement. If you are interested in commuting to Campus, please complete the Off-Campus/Commuter Request Form. Once the form is submitted, your request is reviewed and you'll be contacted with a decision. International Student Reminders

Ensure your flights arrive prior to the start of session 1 classes on August 28. Sign up
for a shuttle from the Cedar Rapids Airport or Iowa City bus stops to Fayette here.
Please note that dates and times listed will be the only available shuttles.
Please coordinate accordingly.



- 2. Double-check your documents now to ensure they are not expiring before your return to the U.S.! Check your passport, U.S. Visa, I-20 (travel signature within past year on page 2) (F-1) or DS-2019 (J-1). Contact Lisa Cameron at cameronl85@uiu.edu as soon as possible if you have any questions or concerns regarding your documents.
- 3. Check your fall course registration. To comply with visa regulations, you must be at full-time status with 12-18 credits per semester (undergraduate student) or six credits per semester (graduate student). Undergraduate students must take a minimum of nine Fayette-coded credits each semester; graduate students need six credits of Fayette-coded credits. There are special circumstances where this rule may be waived, but proper paperwork must be filed. Contact Lisa Cameron at cameronl85@uiu.edu with questions.

Upper lowa University is greatly interested in making each student's academic and personal experience meaningful and successful. Health and wellness are key components of that experience. Non-international students have the option of maintaining primary coverage under a family employee plan or private insurer.

All international (undergraduate, graduate, non-degree and intensive English program) students are required to carry and will be enrolled in the Upper Iowa University student health insurance plan.

Parking Fines and Regulations

The following fine schedule will be used when enforcing parking violations. Note: fines listed are for first-time violations. Fines will be doubled for second-time violations.

No valid parking permit: \$75

No parking space/area: \$50

 Fire lane or blocking a fire hydrant: \$100

Wrong parking lot (staff and visitor): \$25

• Two spaces/over the line: \$15

Blocking driveway access: \$50

Construction zone: \$50

Handicap space: \$100

Third-time violations will result in a wheel lock. A wheel lock will also incur an additional charge of \$20. Vehicles that have been wheel-locked will be towed at the owner's expense after seven calendar days.
